TO ALL REGIONS RE MAGAZINE ISSUE ON EDUCATION

A suggestion has been made by two Regions that our next "special" issue be on Education.

I am willing to attempt it although I am nervous about obtaining articles of sufficient variety and enough photographs, cartoons or drawings to make it interesting and eye-catching.

If I were to be assured of the co-operation of all Regions in securing articles and illustrations, I would feel more confident, as my experiences with the Pass issue have shown that it is essential to have the very best material available.

All the photographs in the Pass issue which were commented on in two leading Newspapers, and the article by Mrs Thage which proved to have the widest appeal, were sent to me, at my request, by the Southern Transvaal Region.
