Dear Everyone,

Here are the provisional Minutes of Conference for your comment and correction, together with copies of Pat Tucker's paper on the Criminal Laws Amendment Act which was not available in sufficient quantities at Conference.

A transcript of the full discussion on the franchise can be made available to anyone who wants it. This was not included in the Minutes as it would have made them very much longer than they already are.

You will see from the Minutes that there are a number of issues about which Regions should concern themselves over and above the four proposed campaigns, but I would like to draw to your attention the suggestions made by Bunty Biggs in connection with U.I.F, which unfortunately got lost when Rev. Jacobs arrived.

I must tell you that having read through the Minutes I came to the conclusion that the Black Sash is an incredible band of women doing an incredible job of work.

I shall be writing a more detailed circular as soon as we have had our meeting about the campaigns and as soon as I am able to reach some conclusions about the Fund Raising Bill, which may well create problems for us.

In the meanwhile, ^{letter} do please remember such practical matters as information for the Wassenaar/- see previous circular and whether or not you want us to order more Black Sash badges. This will depend on whether or not your members want to wear them regularly, which I personally think is a good idea.
