

# KRUISPAD

- ★ Hulle is van een plakkerdorp na die ander uitgestoot.
- ★ Nou het hulle die lelike plakkershuisies warm en gerieflik ingerig.
- ★ Die inwoners van Kruispad is 'n hegte gemeenskap. Volgens Kol. J.H. Vorster, Kommandant, Athlone, hulle is wetsgehoorsaam. (R.D.M. 15.9.78)
- ★ Al wat hulle vra is 'n normale gesinslewe naby hul werkplek!
- As hy die Eerste Minister was het Mn. B. J. Vorster gesê:  
**"n Man se huisie moet hom nie ontnem word nie."**  
**'n Mens hoef nie te dink hy sal ongestraf bly as hy**  
**'n man van sy vaderland vervreem nie."**

# CROSSROADS

## Why is there a Crossroads in the sand dunes outside Cape Town?

- ★ Because since 1966 the Government has refused to build family housing for Africans in the Western Cape.
  - ★ The Government has declared the Western Cape a Coloured Preference Area.
  - ★ But the Western Cape NEEDS African labour.
  - ★ The need for migrant workers has increased 3½ times between 1966 and 1975.
  - ★ 73% of the men and 25% of the women wage-earners in Crossroads are employed in the economy of Cape Town.
  - ★ These African workers have rejected their unnatural life in 'bachelor' hostels and moved to Crossroads, where they have built homes for their families.
  - ★ There are 20 000 men, women and children living in Crossroads.
  - ★ They have been bulldozed from squatter camp to squatter camp.
  - ★ Now they have established homes, comfort and warmth inside their ugly shacks.
  - ★ The people of Crossroads are a close-knit community. According to Colonel J. H. Vorster, Commandant for Athlone, they are law-abiding. (R.D.M. 15.9.78)
  - ★ All they ask is to live a normal family life near their place of work.
- As Prime Minister Mr. B. J. Vorster said:
- "You must not take a man's home away from him."**
- "You must not even think that you will go unpunished if you estrange a man's fatherland from him."**
- ★ Now Crossroads is to be destroyed.
  - ★ Where are the people to go?
- TRANSKEI DOES NOT WANT THEM!
- CISKEI DOES NOT WANT THEM!
- WESTERN CAPE DOES NOT WANT THEM!
- IT ONLY WANTS THEIR LABOUR!

We will all pay the price for this utter contempt for humanity.
