CONSIITUIIONAL AMINDMIENTS. We remind you that if you wish to propose any amendment to the Constitution of the Black Sash Headquarters is obliged to send notice of such amendment to each Region at least thirty days before a National Conference.

- Therefore if you wish to propose any such amendment it should reach us by 31st January 1979, wi thout fail.
OTHIBR RESOLUTIONS AND ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION. Headquarters should ciroulate to all Regions all items submitted for inclusion in the Agenda in time for these items to be discussed at Regional Conferenceswhich will probably be held in the first week of February. It will be very helpful if you could let us have such items either before the Christmas recess i.e. before 15 th December or before 14th Januaxy 1979.
We will obviously aim, as we always do, for a very flexible agenda, with adequate time to-discuss matters which might well arise between now and the Conference. It is not our intention to confine you in any way by asking now for agenda items, but you probably do already have certain matters in mind which you will wish to bring up at Ccnference and it is a great advantage if all Regions have the opportunity to discuss them first.


## NOTICE IS GIVEN OF THE FOLLOWING RESOLUMIONS.

1. That this National Conference ratifies the Constitution of the Black Sash as amended by the Special National Conference held in Johannesburg on July 22nd 1978.

2. CONSTITTUTIONAL AMFNDMPNT : That Section 6 (viii) of the Constitution be amended to substitute the word "All" for the word "Any" and the word "Bearers" for the word, "Bearer", and to delete the words "from each Region" Clause 6 (viii) will now read,

In any year when/- -

In any year when no National Conference is held, the National President shall convene a meeting of all Regional chairmen or their alternates. All
National Office Bearers shall have the right to attend such a meeting but only the National President and the Chairman of each Region, or their alternates, shall have the right to vote. Not less than six weeks' Notice of such a meeting shall be given to all Regional Committees". CONSTITUYIONAL AMENDMENT : That Section 6 (ix) of the Constitution be amended to insert the word "voting" between the words "the" and "provisions" Clause 6 (ix) will now read : "If at any time the National Bxecutive decides that an emergency has arisen the National President or her deputy may call a special Chairments meeting at 24 hours' notice, to which the voting provisions of Section 6 (viii) will apply.
(You have already been notified of amendments 2 and 3 in Circular No $15 / 1978$ ).
4. CONSTITUTIONAL AMIRDMANT : That Section 16 (ii) of the Constitution ha amended to insert the words "present and" between the words "member * $\quad$ "entitlea". Clause 16 (ii) will now read, The provisions of Clauses 2 (Aims and objects), 3 (a) (conditions of Membership), 14, (Affiliation or Incorporation), 15, (Dissolution), and 16 (ii) (this Clause), of this Constitution, may be amended only by a two-thirds majority of the total number of members present and entitlua in terms of Clause 6 (iii) (a) of this Constitution to vote at the National Conference.
