NATIVE LAWS AMENDMENT ACT.

The following resolution was proposed, seconded and passed, with two voting against, at a meeting of the Central Executive on Saturday, 10th August 1957:-

"After due consideration, and taking into account points of view presented by the Chairman on behalf of Southern Transvaal Region, the Regional Secretary Lowveld Region, and the Acting Chairman Orange Free State Region, the Central Executive now feel that in the best interests of the movement, the discussion on the Native Laws Amendment Act should be re-opened.

All points of view will be circularised to Regions, and, through Regions, all Branches, for earnest consideration.

The Central Executive wish, therefore, to refrain from giving a directive until Council meets."

Speakers from the Central Executive will not now address meetings in the Regions as originally planned.
